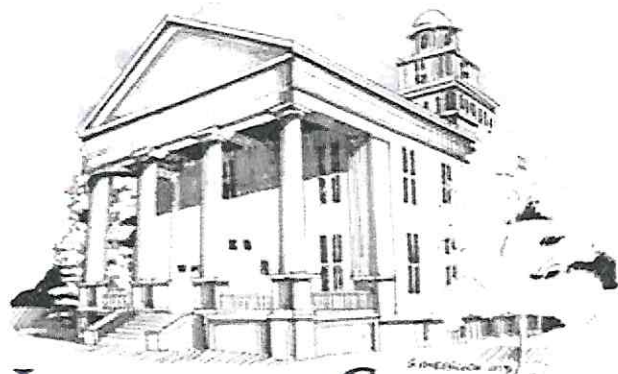

- *Be a graduating senior having established residency in Lapeer County prior to the beginning of the school year;
- *Have a minimum GPA of 2.5 in their last two (2) years of high school;
- *Be a registered voter, OR agree to register to vote within thirty (30) days of their 18th birthday;
- *Submit application, transcript and essay by **Friday, March 31, 2023, 11:59 P.M.**
- *Be prepared to attend, as our guest, the **Saturday, April 15, 2023 Lincoln Day Dinner****, at the Bells Event Center, Almont, for recognition and the announcement of the scholarship winner.
- *The winning applicant is asked to attend the **Thursday, April 20, 2023**, Lapeer County Republican Executive meeting at the Lapeer VFW Hall (Daley Road) for the presentation of their \$1000 check.

Writing the paper:

The typed paper will be 750-1000 words in length. [Your paper may be longer but may not be shorter]

1-inch margins

12-point font [Times New Roman, Arial, Cambria, or Calibri font]

Refer to the attached Rubric to better guide and direct your writing of this paper.

The essay should be clearly written, well organized and have well developed ideas.

The essay should include five (5) or more appropriate sources.

All works must be cited.

The essay will be written in the proper MLA FORMAT.
