ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS: To apply for the Lapeer Lodge #94 Scholarship, an applicant must:

- Hold a High School Degree or its equivalent and must be planning to attend a college, university, technical school or vocational school.
- Must have a minimum of a 2.7 GPA upon completion of their High School studies.
- Complete an application in its entirety to include scholastic and leadership qualifications as well as community involvement.

HOW TO APPLY: Completed applications and required documentation must be postmarked no earlier than April 1, 2019 and later than April 26, 2019. . Hand delivered applications will not be accepted. Mail completed application to:

1. Applicant must use the current official scholarship form, which must be dated and signed by the student. All applications and statements are required to be signed. Typewritten applications are preferred. Handwritten applications must be legible.
2. Official high school transcript of the student's records or if presently attending a school of higher education, the current transcript must be submitted.
3. Applicant must submit a copy of acceptance letter from institution of higher education.
4. A current dated and signed recommendation letter, limited to 150 words or less, from a community leader. The recommendation should detail information related to the demonstration of leadership and community service.

5. Documents will not be returned. Therefore, please send copies of all supporting documentation with the exception of school transcripts which must be originals.
