5. Two written character recommendations from persons not related to you. The recommendations should include the writer's name, address, and telephone number. At least one should be from a teacher or other official from your school.
6. A brief (one page or less) biographical sketch from you that includes your reasons to further your education.
7. A "bulleted resume" of your school activities, volunteer activities, and other information you want to share with us.
8. A brief (one page or less) statement describing one or more of the following: how a teacher or family member or other person or event has greatly influenced your educational or career path.
